

## 2022-23 FEES AND PENALTIES - AGRICULTURE

In accordance with the Monetary Units Act 2004 the current value for 2022-23 is:  
Fee unit **\$15.29**  
Penalty Unit **\$164.92**

The amount of penalties are determined by multiplying the number of penalty units contained in the legislation by the current value of the penalty unit (section 7(2)) and rounded to the nearest dollar (section 7(4))

Penalty units have been rounded to the nearest dollar and fee units rounded to the nearest 10 cents in accordance with sections 7(3) and 7(4) of the Monetary Units Act 2004, with exception to the Plant Biosecurity Act 2010 (PBA) fees and Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Control of Use) Act 1992 fees, which have been rounded down to the nearest 5 cents (in accordance with s.55(3) of the PBA) and Notice of Fixing Fees accordingly.
